Forward stateroom: Double island bed, large hanging locker, en-suite access to head with separate shower, screened hatch, lighted vanity, portlights

Galley: step-down from salon, ample storage with large convertible dinette opposite, maple hardwood floor Salon: Ultraleather sofa bed, flat screen TV, stereo system, wicker side chairs and table, screened opening side windows, closed cabinet storage space, limed oak cabinetry and paneling, window screens

Aft Cockpit: self bailing with storage wells and stepthrough transom to extended swim platform, wet bar w/ice maker, sliding door access to salon, ladder to bridge, molded steps to sidewalks, canvas eyebrow awning, lazarette storage
