


The 42 Convertible flybridge sedan was a popular seller for Silverton over the 2000-2012 production years. With contemporary styling, spacious interior and large cockpit, it continues to appeal to active families and anglers alike. The two-stateroom interior is a tasteful blend of cherry woodwork and earth-tone fabrics. Both staterooms provide comfortable double berth accommodations and the master stateroom has en-suite access to separate head and shower compartments.

On deck, the cockpit has easily accessible engine access hatches, a walk-thru transom and a built-in tackle centre. Molded steps ascend to the bridge with centre-line helm and passenger bench seating forward.

This 42 Convertible has the optional flybridge hardtop with full bridge enclosure in white Stamoid. Bridge and cockpit floor areas have been updated with great looking, easily maintained, Infinity marine flooring.
