One of Tollycraft's most successful, best selling models, the 44 Aft Cabin Cockpit Motor Yacht offers an unlimited versatility and attractive exterior lines. The unique Ed Monk Jr. "Quadra Lift" hull design provides great stability and economical performance resulting in an extremely comfortable motor yacht for extended cruising.

Leisure Lady III is a Great Lakes freshwater vessel, and has been diligently maintained and serviced by her current owners. She is well equipped with accommodations for cruising or live-aboard, with a full-beam aft cabin with private head, a forward stateroom, a large open salon bathed in warm natural light through massive cabin windows, and a stepped-down galley with large dinette and breakfast bar.

Above decks, the full-beam, enclosed aft deck is the perfect spot for entertaining and offers easy access to the salon, bridge and cockpit areas. The sidedecks are wide and safe, and can be reached from both aft deck and salon, and the bridge has comfortable pedestal seating at the helm and bench seating aft. When Mother Nature fails to cooperate, a well equipped lower helm keeps the captain warm and dry and allows easy access to decks when docking. Amidship, a very clean, dry, and orderly engine compartment houses two big block engines that have obviously been well maintained along with other mechanical systems. The generator is located well aft below the cockpit making for quiet operation and good access.

If you are looking for comfort and performance in a proven cruising platform, or a just very comfortable live-aboard, Liesure Lady III is an absolute "must see."

Salon: L-shaped sofa converts to double berth, coffee table with storage, flatscreen TV, stereo system, breakfast bar with stools (2), ice maker, wine storage, lower helm position, starboard side access door, new vinyl teak & holly cabin sole (2014)

Command Bridge: Centerline helm with pedestal helm seats (3), passenger seating aft, new full canvas enclosure (2016)

Aft Deck: hardtop with electronics arch, polycarbonate wing doors to sidewalks, canvas enclosure, carpet, wicker tub chairs (2) and matching table, ladder access to cockpit, molded steps to bridge and salon

Cockpit: Self-draining, with transom door, exceptionally large lazarette storage area, canvas cover (2012), swim platform with boarding ladder
