Broker's Comments:

Campion Boats of Kelowna BC was Canada's largest independent fiberglass boat builder and has maintained a stellar reputation over 45 years of operation. Campion's 300 Trawler line continues to be a favourite among distance cruisers for excellent seaworthiness, cruising comfort and unparalleled fuel economy. This Campion 300 has been outfitted for trouble-free extended tripping and has a cruising range of approximately 1000 miles. The single 135hp Volvo diesel has been scrupulously maintained and numerous cruising upgrades have been added over the years, including auxiliary solar power and high quality refrigeration. If extended cruising is on your bucket list, be sure to give "Paradiso" a good long look.



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Paradiso has been renewed and outfitted as a self reliant cruising boat intended specifically for Georgian Bay and the North Channel. It is safe, simple, easy to maintain and economical.

Power is provided by a 135 HP PentaVolvo diesel which has been maintained scrupulously and which has never had any issues. Twin Racor filters provide an extra measure of security. At 6.5 kts in smooth water the engine consumes about a gallon an hour. The boat has a range of approximately 1000 miles.

Views from the cabin and the fly bridge are spectacular and unimpeded. The fly bridge is spacious and an overlarge bimini on the fly bridge provides shade for crew and guests. The canvas has been configured to cope with a variety of weather events: open air cruising from the fly bridge; a full surround enclosure with screens for times when the weather is cool or wet. For major storm events, the enclosure can be taken down and replaced by a tonneau cover to reduce windage. With this configuration, the boat is comfortable and quiet in 40 kt winds.

Anchoring is easy and secure with the Lewmar windlass and an all chain rode and an original Bruce anchor which has never dragged. Paradiso can easily be tied to shore with the use of lines and golf cart tires which protect the boat from rock walls. Alternatively, the boat can be tucked into tiny coves and spider webbed to shore. This versatility enables the crew to go anywhere. Further, the extended skeg protects the prop in the event that depths get a bit challenging. The boat draws 3.5 feet.

The electrical system has been designed so that the boat can rest on the hook for days without the need to run a supplemental generator or run the engine. Two 100W flexible solar panels are mounted on top of the bimini for this purpose. A high end Stirling battery charger is capable of charging three battery banks: starting, house, and a trolling battery used to power the dinghy. A 1100W inverter with two outlets equipped with USB ports is used to recharge electrical devices.

The boat is ideal for a couple with sleeping accommodation provided in a well ventilated vee berth. The galley has been reconfigured from the original version to double the counter space and storage. Soft LED lighting provides great illumination for tasks at night. A new three burner unit is equipped with fiddle rails and a stainless steel backsplash for safety. A super-insulated top loading fridge/freezer was installed to economize on the consumption of electricity. It can be supplemented by coolers or portable electric fridge/freezers.

The main cabin is bright and airy, again with LED lighting hidden in the valence along the port side. Some legacy lighting has been retained to respect the traditional design of the boat. New cushion coverings and an abundance of seat cushions offer comfort while lounging. The sound system is supported by new Bose speakers. There is also a ton of accessible storage via sliding drawers under the seating and along the starboard side. (One holds 2 cases of wine.)

The swim platform is large and equipped with Weaver davits. A cockpit shower, a large amount of storage space in the lazarette and a detachable large BBQ platform complete the layout. The table is much better than a rail mounted system as it provides room for plates and utensils and is more sheltered from the wind when the boat is at anchor.
