A beautifully proportioned sport yacht with homeaway-from-home comfort. Introduced in 1989, Sea Ray's 380 Aft Cabin blends easy handling, agile maneuverability and excellent performance in a surprisingly spacious, wide-beam foot print. The bridge provides comfortable captain and companion chairs, a wrap-around instrument console and a stylish rear-swept radar arch. Both the bridge and the hardtop aft deck are enclosed with updated canvas systems. Port and starboard wing doors provide access to side and foredeck areas, and a transom door leads to a wide, upgraded swim platform.

Below decks, aft and forward staterooms, each with access to separate heads, provide maximum privacy for owners and guests. Additional sleeping accommodation for four is provided by a convertible dinette and sofa in the salon. The stepped-down galley is well equipped with full-size fridge and plenty of cupboard storage.

This 380 Aft Cabin has seen numerous upgrades over the years. In addition to regular ongoing maintenance and repairs, the electrical system has been augmented with solar power to extend cruising capability, the generator has recently been rebuilt, a high capacity inverter system was added and the original canvas systems were replaced.

Overall, this is a well equipped and time-tested cruiser with many more years of service ahead of her. If you are looking to maximize value for your boating dollar, you really need to give this classic Sea Ray a good long look!
